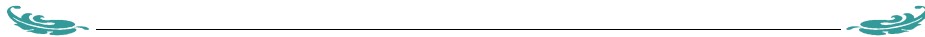

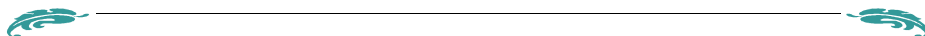
The ***DuPage County CourtWatch*** program is seeking volunteers to monitor domestic violence cases in the DuPage County judicial system.

As a volunteer, you would be part of a community effort to promote accountability, fairness, and consistency in court cases involving domestic violence. Through an on-going court monitoring process, we hope to collect data on the current system and offer any recommendations for improvement.

Volunteers will have the opportunity to learn more about how the judicial system works, as well as, the dynamics of domestic violence. We will need volunteers with daytime availability - one may volunteer for a morning or an afternoon - and the schedule can be flexible.



To become a ***DuPage County CourtWatch*** volunteer, one must successfully complete the application process which includes completion of a volunteer application, interview, and full day training session, which will cover the Illinois Domestic Violence Act, the nature and dynamics of domestic violence, criminal and civil justice processes, and court monitoring basics.
