## SNAP BENEFITS RETURN TO PRE-PANDEMIC LEVELS

Your SNAP emergency allotment will end in March as a result of federal policy changes.

SNAP benefits increased during COVID-19 due to the public health emergency. Since April 2020, Illinois LINK households received their regular monthly benefit and an emergency SNAP issuance.

February 2023 will be the last month you will receive your emergency SNAP allotment.
