Illinois Eviction Moratorium

- Currently expires on February 6 (may be extended and/or changed)
- Prohibits landlords from **filing some** residential eviction cases
 - Requires eligible tenants facing eviction for non-payment of rent to give their landlords a signed Declaration
- Prohibits law enforcement from **enforcing most** residential eviction orders
- Evictions based on the **health & safety of other tenants** and a **severe risk to property** are allowed



CDC Moratorium

- Goes at least until March 31, 2021
- Small group of tenants are protected under the CDC moratorium but not the IL moratorium
