***SNAP Resource Limits**

Categorically Eligible SNAP Households

SNAP asset limits do not apply to categorically eligible households **unless the household receives substantial lottery or gambling winnings as a cash prize of more than \$4,500**, see [PM 07-04-21](#).

Noncategorically Eligible SNAP Households

The asset limits for noncategorically eligible SNAP households are:

- \$4,500 if at least one member in the household is a qualifying member (see [PM 05-06-01](#)); or
- \$3,000 for all other SNAP households without a qualifying member; or
- \$4,500 for lottery or gambling winnings, see [PM 07-04-21](#).

Medicaid – MAGI Programs: Resources are not a factor for MAGI Budgeted Programs. However, if the applicant needs nursing home care (long term care, long term services and supports), they will need to provide information about resources.
