

If you answered YES to all of the above questions, you may be considered an ABAWD (Able-Bodied Adult Without Dependents) & may be at risk of only receiving SNAP benefits for 3 months out of the 36-month period beginning on January 1, 2020 - UNLESS you meet the work requirement or are otherwise exempt.

What should you do?

[©] Open all mail you receive from your DHS office so you do not miss important information about your benefits.

[©] Visit your DHS office to ensure your SNAP Case is accurate, including:

Your employment information - especially the number of hours you work

[•] Your children's information (if applicable)

^c If you are applying for or receiving unemployment
